



TO REPAIR/REPLACE A BROKEN SECTION (FIBREGLASS)

Untie the shock cord which runs through the pole, from the end nearest to the damaged section.

Remove complete sections, keeping them in order, until you have removed the broken one.

Cut the replacement section to the correct length, with a hacksaw, using one of the other sections as a guide.

File the cut end to remove sharp/ragged edges. Re-thread the sections, making sure they are in the correct order.

Repeat this process until all sections are re-threaded, and then tie off shock cord to secure.

POLE SET ASSEMBLY (FIBREGLASS)

Cut the replacement sections to the correct length, with a hacksaw, using the original pole as a guide, if possible.

File the cut ends to remove sharp/ragged edges.

1. Tie a knot at one end of the length of shock cord.
2. Thread the cord through the pole sections, push the hooked end of the threader through the unferruled end of the pole and hook the un-knotted end of the cord, on to the threader.
3. Pull the threader and cord, back through the pole section.
4. Repeat this process until all sections are re-threaded, then tie off shock cord to secure.
5. The loose ferrule can be positioned between any 2 sections when assembling pole.
